Re: Notice of Violation Regarding Junked Vehicle

This is a Notice of Violation that you are not in compliance with the City of Victoria Code of Ordinances regarding Junked Vehicles. Specifically:

- **Section 10-51(c).** “The presence of any junk vehicle on any private lot, tract, or parcel of land, occupied or unoccupied, improved or unimproved, or on any public right-of-way or other public property, within the city or on city property, that is visible from a public place or public right-of-way is prohibited. Any person who allows a junk vehicle to exist on their property or who owns a vehicle and allows it to exist in a state which qualifies as a junk vehicle under this code shall be guilty of a misdemeanor as listed in 1-8 of this code.”

- 1986 gray/black Chevy SUV parked at the property of 1516 Harry and last observed on February 20, 2026 at 10:22 am.
- 1986 gray/black Chevy SUV parked at the property of 1516 Harry. The SUV has flat tires, has been sitting for an extended period of time in the same location, and does not appear operable. It has expired registration from Aug/2015. The junk vehicle appears inoperable and is considered a nuisance.

If you do not become compliant with the City’s Code of Ordinances within ten (10) calendar days from the date on this letter, you may be subject to different enforcement actions. This can include, but is not limited to, the appropriate City administrative official issuing an administrative order, an abatement order, and/or assessing civil penalties of no more than \$1,000.00 per day for each day you remain non-compliant.

The goal of the City of Victoria is to obtain compliance with its codes and we can assist you by answering questions and directing you to compliance options. If you become compliant, you must still notify me, in writing, at the point you have become compliant in order to prevent any enforcement actions from be taken against you. If we do not hear from you and you are not compliant by the deadline, the City will move forward with compliance enforcement authorized by law.
